The Erie County Fair at Wattsburg animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. Appropriate documentation of necessary immunizations must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds for all animals. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Erie County Fair at Wattsburg Premium Book.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

(All General Rules apply).

- 1. 4-H and FFA members will be admitted to the Fair grounds free of charge with a 4-H or FFA identification card (does not include rides and grandstand admission.)
- 2. 4-H and FFA members must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.
- 3. All 4-H and FFA entries must be accompanied by a Project Book. All Project Books must be brought in to the Fair Office Secretary on the day of entry; not to be given to Department superintendents.
- 4. Unless otherwise stated, all rules and regulations in Departments 1,2,3,4,5 & 6 apply to Department 10.
- 5. Eligibility: 4-H Club members must have passed their eighth birthday, but not have passed their nineteenth. Birthday by January 1st of the current year. Exhibitors must be 4-H members and have a project in the field in the supervision of Pennsylvania State University Cooperative Extension Service by July 1st, preceding the Fair
- 6. Students enrolled in an accepted vocational school curriculum must be conducting a project in the class in which they wish to make entry. Students enrolled in general home economics in a comprehensive high school are considered as qualifying. All entries shall be approved prior to the Fair by a member of the Pennsylvania Department of Education, Agriculture or Home Economics staff, or their designated representative.
- 7. NOTE: In any case where there is reference to 4-H and vocational classes, the Fair has the option, if there are a sufficient number of available exhibits, to divide the show into two: one for 4-H and one for vocational, or they may be shown together.
