Health Requirements:

The Erie County Fair at Wattsburg animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. Appropriate documentation of necessary immunizations must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds for all animals. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Erie County Fair at Wattsburg Premium Book.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries must include a fair entry form, CVI, NEGATIVE Coggins, and registration papers (if applicable), to be considered complete. All incomplete entries will be returned. Stalls are being reserved on a first come first served basis ONLY, with a completed entry form and payment.
2. Entries open Sunday, August 27, 2023 at 9:00 AM and close at 8:00 PM August 27, 2023. Horse must be on grounds by August 27, 2023 @ 8:00 PM.
3. Exhibitor is responsible for daily care and feeding of animals and also daily removal of manure from barn.
4. All hitch entries must have been shown in the appropriate halter class.
5. The Fair reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Tie stalls only except for mares with foals.
6. No riding of animals after 6:00 pm
7. Ribbons must be on display over animal.
8. All exhibits will be under the control and direction of the live - stock committee, but the Fair will in no case be responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any animal exhibited by the exhibitor.
9. The Fair Board will put forth every effort to protect all exhibits, but all exhibitors of livestock will be responsible for the care and feeding of the animals.
10. The committee reserves the right to reject or to remove any animal they feel will endanger the public.
11. Age of all animals will be determined from January 1 of the year of birth.
12. Smoking and alcoholic beverages in the barn is forbidden by rules and regulations of the Fair.
13. Senior Class - 13 to 17 years old.
14. Junior Class - 7 to 12 years old.
15. Junior Class must be accompanied by an adult.

(All general rules apply)

Health Requirements:

The Erie County Fair at Wattsburg animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. Appropriate documentation of necessary immunizations must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds for all animals. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Erie County Fair at Wattsburg Premium Book.

1. All entries must include a fair entry form, CVI, NEGATIVE Coggins, and registration papers (if applicable), to be considered complete. All incomplete entries will be returned. Stalls are being reserved on a first come first served basis ONLY, with a completed entry form and payment.
2. Entries open Sunday, August 27, 2023 at 9:00 AM and close at 8:00 PM August 27, 2023. Horse must be on grounds by August 27, 2023 @ 8:00 PM.
3. Judging starts Monday, August 28, 2023.
4. All entries must be on Fair Entry Forms. No additional sheets accepted. May make copies of entry forms.
5. All horses must have copies of registration papers or will be placed in the "all other" class. No exceptions.
6. Stallions may not be handled or shown by minors under the age of 18.
7. A horse can only be entered in one breed lot listed below. For example: A Palomino Quarter Horse can only be entered in EITHER Lot E as a Registered Quarter Horse or Lot H as Unregistered Palomino horse. But NOT in both.
8. Showmanship awards will be given at end of halter classes per judges discretion.
9. One adult and one child master showmanship will be awarded.
10. Multiple awards may be given to acknowledge other participants per judges discretion.
11. Judge may choose from exhibitors who show in halter. They may also have exhibitors perform a showmanship pattern before making their final decision.
12. Exhibitors may use any horse they showed in halter to run the pattern.
