Health Requirements:

The Eric County Fair at Wattsburg animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. Appropriate documentation of necessary immunizations must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds for all animals. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Eric County Fair at Wattsburg Premium Book.

RULES & REGULATIONS (All General Rules Apply)

- 1. All entries must be on Fair Entry Forms; no additional sheets accepted. May make photo copies of Fair Entry Form.
- 2. Entries open Sunday, August 25, 2024 at 9:00 AM and close at 8:00 PM August 25, 2024. Animals must be on grounds by August 25, 2024 @ 8:00 PM. JUDGING BEGINS TUESDAY, August 27, 2024.
- 3. AN "ANIMAL Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form must be presented upon arrival at all shows and fairs in Pennsylvania, including out-of-state entries. (Form included at back of this Premium Book.)
- 4. All breeding stock must be Pure-bred animals (unless otherwise stated). any animal over six months of age must be recorded in the Registry Association for the respective breed.
- 5. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor 30 days prior to this show.
- 6. Any animal or animals entered in a person's name, other than the names or name on the Registration Certificate, shall be barred from competition and will receive no premiums.
- 7. The Superintendent reserves the right to bar from competition animals with decidedly inferior conformation and those not possessing sufficient merit to warrant recognition.
- 8. No more than two entries will be accepted for any premium.
- 9. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the superintendent, to accept the stall assigned without controversy, to keep their animals in an attractive appearance and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.
- 10. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged. Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competing. Decorations with ribbons previously won by animals at shows shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the Judges.
- 11. No person shall be allowed in the ring while the stock is being judged except the Judge, superintendent and necessary attendants.
- 12. The exhibitors will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the superintendent may direct.
- 13. Responsibility for accident: The Eric County Fair at Wattsburg shall not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any animals exhibited at the show; the exhibitor shall hold it blameless and indemnity it against any legal proceeding arising from any such accident.
- 14. Dual purpose animals registered in both Beef and Dairy may be shown in either department, but not both.
