

ANGEL FOOD CAKE CONTEST RULES

- 1. Open to any individual amateur baker who is a Pennsylvania resident. One entry per person.
- 2. Entrants may <u>NOT</u> have won 1st place in this Angel Food Cake contest at any other fair in 2025.
- 3. The Cake and any Fillings and Frostings must be **made from scratch with edible ingredients**. No pre-packaged ingredients may be used (ex: no pre-made mixes, cookie dough, pie crust, frosting, etc.). Any decorations must just be edible.
- 4. The recipe shall include eggs that were produced in Pennsylvania, if possible.
- 5. The entire cake entry must be submitted for judging <u>on cardboard or other food safe</u> <u>disposable setting</u>. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
- 6. The Cake entry and its recipes will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.
- 7. Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted with the entry (*printed on one-side of 8-1/2" x 11" size sheets of paper*). Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back of all the pages.
- 8. Refrigeration is NOT available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned, or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
- 9. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

Flavor (aroma, taste, good balance of flavorings)	40 points
Inside Characteristics (texture & lightness)	30 points
Overall Appearance (surface, shape, size, color)	20 points
Topping, Icing, Decoration	10 points

FAIR PRIZES: $1^{st} = \$25$ $2^{nd} = \$15$ $3^{rd} = \$10$

First Place Winner is eligible for the **2026 PA Farm Show** competition.

Rules:

1. Purpose: To create a display of toys that depicts an aspect of farm life. Does not have to be a whole farm set up. Can depict a western ranch, dairy farm, horse farm, grain farm, beef, goat, chicken, etc.

- 2. Acceptable items to use: any toy that will help detail farm life (house, barn, animals, action figures, equipment dolls, etc)
- 3. Must fit on the table size stated per age group.
- 4. Age groups: 4 and under, 5-7, 8-11, 12-14
- 5. Tables/bases may be made at home but must meet size requirements. No toys or buildings can be permanently attached to the base or table. The display **MUST** be set up at fair. Tables will be provided if you do not have your own.
- 6. Table sizes: 4 ft. table ages 7 and under; 6 ft. table ages 8-14
- 7. Judging is based on neatness, creativity, originality, realism, and variety of toys used.
- 8. Entries must be checked in and completed by 11 am Sunday August 24, 2025.
