Health Requirements:

The Erie County Fair animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. Appropriate documentation of necessary immunizations must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds for all animals. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Erie County Fair Premium Book.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

(All General Rules apply).

1. 4-H and FFA members must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.
2. All 4-H and FFA entries must be accompanied by a Project Book. All Project Books must be presented to the Department Superintendent on the day of entry.
3. Unless otherwise stated, all rules and regulations in Departments 2,3,4,5 & 6 apply to Department 10.
4. Eligibility: 4-H Club members must have passed their eighth birthday but not have passed their nineteenth. Birthday by January 1st of the current year. Exhibitors must be 4-H members and have a project in the field in the supervision of Pennsylvania State University Cooperative Extension Service by July 1st, preceding the Fair.
5. Students enrolled in an accepted vocational school curriculum must be conducting a project in the class in which they wish to make entry. Students enrolled in general home economics in a comprehensive high school are considered as qualifying. All entries shall be approved prior to the Fair by a member of the Pennsylvania Department of Education, Agriculture or Home Economics staff, or their designated representative.
6. NOTE: In any case where there is reference to 4-H and vocational classes, the Fair has the option, if there are a sufficient number of available exhibits, to divide the show into two: one for 4-H and one for vocational, or they may be shown together.

RULES & REGULATIONS (All General Rules Apply)

1. All entries must be on Fair Entry Forms or online at Fairentry.com; no additional sheets accepted. May make photocopies of Fair Entry Form.
2. Entries open Saturday, August 23, 2025 at 8:00 AM and close at 8:00 PM August 24, 2025. Animals must be on grounds by August 24, 2025 @ 11:00 AM. JUDGING BEGINS Monday, August 25, 2025.
3. AN "ANIMAL Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form must be presented upon arrival at all shows and fairs in Pennsylvania, including out-of-state entries. (Form included at back of this Premium Book.)
4. All animals must be owned or leased by the exhibitor 30 days prior to this show.
5. Any animal or animals entered in a person's name, other than the names or name on the Registration Certificate, shall be barred from competition and will receive no premiums.
6. The Superintendent reserves the right to bar from competition animals with decidedly inferior conformation and those not possessing sufficient merit to warrant recognition.
7. No more than two entries will be accepted for each class.
8. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the superintendent, to accept the stall assigned without controversy, to keep their animals in an attractive appearance and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.
9. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged. Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competing. Decorations with ribbons

previously won by animals at shows shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the Judges.

10. No person shall be allowed in the ring while the stock is being judged except the Judge, superintendent and necessary attendants, at the discretion of the superintendent and judge.

11. The exhibitors will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the superintendent may direct.

12. Responsibility for accident: The Erie County Fair shall not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any animals exhibited at the show; the exhibitor shall hold it blameless and indemnity it against any legal proceeding arising from any such accident.

13. Dual purpose animals registered in both Beef and Dairy may be shown in either department, but not both.
