2. Six (6) ears will be the quantity entered to show corn in classes 1-9.
3. One to three (1 to 3) stalks will be the quantity entered to show grain in classes 10, 11, & 12.
4. One gallon glass jars, with lids, are to be used to show grain in classes 15-34, unless otherwise specified.
5. Hay and straw entries will be one flake.
6. Silage and Haylage entries will be in a 1-gallon glass container with lid.
7. All articles entered for display cannot be entered for a single display.
